FAIR OAKS

STOP 1: 505 KENNESAW AVE,
MARIETTA, GA 30060

Built between 1850–1852, Fair Oaks is one of the oldest antebellum homes in Marietta and serves as the home of the Marietta Educational Garden Center.

Today, Fair Oaks offers:

- Event rental space
 - Free educational gardening resources
 - Monthly meeting space for the Marietta Daisies Garden Club

STOP 2: 144 POLK ST NW,
MARIETTA, GA 30064

Originally built in 1952 as Marietta Fire Department Station No. 3, this historic building now houses the Marietta Schools Foundation.

In 2018, the Marietta Daisies Garden Club began a four-phase landscape installation plan for the grounds, strengthening a growing partnership that supports continued garden restoration efforts in Marietta.
